# THE SEVENTE TRUNCTURE (REVELATION 11:15-19)






It's the moment that all creation has been longing for. It's the moment that the Church of all ages has been yearning for. It is the most anticipated and glorious moment in all of human history!

## IT'S THE SOUNDING OF THE SEVENTH TRUMPET!

For the first time, the Church of Jesus Christ will become fully mature as the Bride. Jesus will return in all His glory. The dead saints will be resurrected and the living saints raptured. And the kingdom of God will be manifested and established here on earth!

Romans 8:18-19 tells us that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy compared to the glory that will be revealed in the sons of God. Indeed, all creation is eagerly waiting and the End-Time saints are yearning for this moment!

There are **six events** that will happen at the seventh trumpet:



At the seventh trumpet, there are heavenly voices that proclaim that the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ. Jesus will return and He will replace the governments of the Earth with righteous leaders. This is where the resurrected and the rapture<u>d saints</u> will be aiven governmental leadership roles. For the first time, Jesus will fully exert His power and His reign over all the nations of the earth!

2) The nations were angry with the leadership of Jesus and they waged war against Him (*Rev. 11:18a*)

At the sixth trumpet, one third of the world population dies. The nations will become angry and offended with God and they will wage war against Jesus. Led by the Antichrist, they will attack the nation of Israel and seek to destroy it. Jesus will completely defeat them at the final battle at the Valley of Jehoshaphat near the Mount of Olives.

#### 3) God will release the fullness of His wrath to destroy His enemies (Rev. 11:18)

At the sixth trumpet, one third of the world population dies. The nations will become angry and offended with God and they will wage war against Jesus. Led by the Antichrist, they will attack the nation of Israel and seek to destroy it. Jesus will completely defeat them at the final battle at the Valley of Jehoshaphat near the Mount of Olives.

#### 4) The unrighteous dead will be judged at the Second Coming of Jesus

(Rev. 11:18b; 2 Thes. 1:6-10; 2 Tim. 4:1)

Jesus will judge the unrighteous dead at His Second Coming. These are the followers of Antichrist who are killed during the bowl judgments. They will be thrown into Hades for 1000 years, before they are finally judged at the Great White Throne judgment and cast into the lake of fire. 5) The saints will be rewarded (*Rev. 11:18c*)

The raptured and resurrected saints will be quickly evaluated and rewarded at the moment they meet Jesus in the sky. They will be given white garments and crowns (Rev. 19:8,14; 2 Tim. 4:8).

## 6) The temple of God in heaven will be opened up (*Rev. 11:19*)

The temple of God in heaven will be opened up, and the Ark of the Covenant will be seen, manifesting God's glory through lightning, thunderings, noises, earthquake and great hail. The glory of God will be revealed like never before and it will be both glorious and terrifying. We know that the **Great Tribulation**. whose start is marked by the rise of the Antichrist (the first seal, Rev. 6:1-2) and the event of the Abomination of Desolation (Dan. 9:27; Matt. 24:15,21), will last for three and a half years or 1260 days (Dan. 7:25; 12:1,7; Rev. 11:2-3; 13:5-8). It ends at the seventh and last trumpet where Jesus will return, the dead saints will be resurrected and the living saints raptured (Matt. 24:29-31; 1 Thes. 4:15-17; 1 Cor. 15:51-52).

However, Daniel 12:8 and 11 tell us that the Abomination of Desolation will last 1290 days. Why is there a difference of 30 days?

You see, the difference of 30 days is the time between the sounding of the seventh trumpet and Jesus' entry into the temple in Jerusalem to cleanse it of all defilements left by the Antichrist worship.




### WHAT HAPPENS DURING THOSE 30 DAYS?

The Second Coming Procession of Jesus. The Second Coming of Jesus is not a one-day event. The entire procession will take around 30 days!



There are actually three stages to the Second Coming Procession of Jesus:




Revelation 1:7 tells us that every eye will see Jesus when He returns on the clouds with power and great glory. It will take days for Jesus to traverse the earth in the sky in order for everyone on the earth to see Him.

Jesus will then land somewhere in Egypt, likely to be on Mount Sinai (Isa. 19:1; Deut. 33:2). This marks the start of the **Procession of Jesus on the Land from Egypt to the Mount of Olives**. Along the journey, He will release the seven bowls of wrath upon the army of the Antichrist (Isa. 34:5-10; Hab. 3:3-13).

Jesus will march with His saints Jordan (Edom. Bozrah. through Teman), delivering the Jewish captives from prisons and gathering Jewish people who are taking refuge from the Antichrist (Isa. 63:1-4; Hab. 3:3-13). He then enters into Israel to fight the final battle with the Antichrist and the nations at the Valley of Jehoshaphat (Joel 3:1-2;12-13; Zech. 14:1-5). He defeats the Antichrist and the eyes of all the Jewish people will finally be opened to recognize that Yeshua is their promised Messiah. The entire nation of Israel will then turn to Jesus and will welcome Him into Jerusalem to rule and reign as their King (Matt. 23:39; Ps. 24:7-10)!

When we look at the Jewish feasts, we can get an insight into Jesus' First and Second Coming. The spring feasts of Passover (Pesach), First Fruits (Bikkurim) and the Feast of Weeks (Shavuot or Pentecost) pertain to Jesus' death on the cross, resurrection and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. They have been fulfilled in the First Coming of Jesus. The fall feasts pertain to the Second Coming of Jesus. The Rosh Hashanah (the Feast of Trumpets) ushers in the Ten Days of **Repentance** or the **Days** of Awe which culminate on Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement. The trumpet blasts during the Rosh Hashanah are God's warning to the Jewish people of the coming judgment so that they will repent and turn to Him. Similarly, the seven trumpet judgments at the End of the Age are announcing the coming of the King. They are warning us of the final judgments of God and calling Israel and unbelievers to repentance.





The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur) speaks of the national repentance of Israel. This will be seen when the entire nation calls on Jesus Him and welcomes into Jerusalem. Yom **Kippur** is the holiest day of the year. This is the only time in the year when the high priest will enter the Holy of holies in the temple to make atonement for the sins of the people (Lev. 16:2-34; 23:26-32; Heb. 9:11-28; 10:1-25). This will be re-enacted when Jesus enters Jerusalem, goes into the tribulation temple, cleans up the temple and then initiates the start of the Millennium Kingdom.

Finally, the Feast of the Tabernacles or Sukkot speaks of God's desire to tabernacle and dwell with men forever (Lev. 23:33-43; Deut. 16:13-15; Zech. 14:16-19; John 7:1-10,37-39). Having entered Jerusalem and cleansed the temple, Jesus will initiate His kingdom here on earth. He will dwell on the earth with men forever!

Indeed, in the days of the sounding of the seventh trumpet, the mystery of God will be completed (Rev. 10:7)! Jesus will finally have His mature Bride who will rule and reign with Him.



AND THE KINGDOMS OF THIS WORLD WILL BECOME THE KINGDOMS OF OUR LORD AND HIS CHRIST. GOD'S KINGDOM WILL FINALLY BE ESTABLISHED HERE ON EARTH AND JESUS WILL REIGN FOREVER AND EVER. !
