WHAT THE BOOK OF REVELATION IS ABOUT" (PART 2)



IHOP - ONE THING MINISTRIES



From the previous session, we learn that the primary theme of the Book of Revelation is the glory, majesty, and splendour of Jesus at His Second Coming. It is about this Man Christ Jesus, His personality, His power, and His action plan for the Church.

But why does the Book of Revelation focus on the Person of Jesus? What is the end goal when we study the Book of Revelation?

THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS TO PRODUCE IN OUR HEARTS THE **YEARNING FOR JESUS** TO COME BACK.

When we really know this Man, our hearts will yearn for Him. We will want Him to return.

Right now, do believers around the world have the yearning for Jesus to return? To be honest, No! By and large, we do not.

WHY?

The reason is that we do not have the right perspective and picture of this Man. What does this mean?

You see, when we realize that this Man is

ABSOLUTELY BEAUTIFUL, ALTOGETHER LOVELY, TRULY MAJESTIC, AND FULL OF SPLENDOUR,

our hearts will move and we will naturally yearn and long for Him.

WHEN WE SEE JESUS AS HE IS, HOW COULD WE NOT WANT HIM TO RETURN?

The early Christians and the First Century Church had a yearning for Jesus' return. That is why they taught on the End Times. The freshness of their memories of Jesus continually stirred up a deep longing in their hearts to be reunited with this glorious Man. They prayed, talked about it and gave their all, seeking to hasten His return.

But over the centuries, we have lost that yearning because our picture of who Jesus is has faded away. As the sovereignty and supremacy of Jesus gave way to a picture of a "sensible and modern spiritual man", adoring worship from an overflowing heart has also given way to intellectualism and lifeless religion.

The eyes of our understanding need to be opened once again to who this glorious Son of God, Son of Man is. This is where the Book of Revelation comes in, to bring forth revelation, to breathe life and to create and stir up a yearning for Jesus!

Listen to the final statement of Jesus in the Book of Revelation and the response of John in Revelation 22:20:

HE WHO TESTIFIES TO THESE THINGS SAYS, "SURELY I AM COMING QUICKLY." AMEN. EVEN SO, COME, LORD JESUS!

(Rev. 22:20)

Can you feel the rush of emotions and excitement in John's heart when he heard Jesus say that He is coming quickly?

John's heart literally leapt with an exuberant and joyous "Yes! Yes! Yes! Amen, come Lord Jesus, come!!". He couldn't wait for that Day to see His Beloved face to face again.

John is looking forward to Jesus' Second Coming. On that Day when we see Jesus face to face, we will know that all the sufferings and tribulations we have gone through are truly worth it. In fact, we will realize that they are nothing compared to the glorious excellence of Christ Jesus. And it is this Blessed Hope of seeing Him again that keeps our hearts burning!




John encountered the glory of Jesus on the island of Patmos. But there was another thing he saw — the glory of the Church in the last days. This is the secondary theme of this book.
